# Mr. Sieloff's Choir Trip Rules

(Memorize Them)

- 1) **SMILE. ENJOY YOURSELF**  
Keep in mind what a wonderful opportunity this is.
- 2) **ENJOY EVERYONE ON THE TRIP**  
Don't hang out with only a few other people. Contribute to the group. Make a new friendship with someone in choir.
- 3) **NO WHINING**  
...or unnecessary complaining.
- 4) **KEEP TRACK OF YOUR BELONGINGS**  
Don't lose anything. Bring what you need to make you happy—blankets, books, games, food, music, etc...
- 5) **5% RULE**  
This is the maximum amount of time that you are allowed to be irritated, grouchy, bored, or otherwise out of sorts.
- 6) **DON'T BE ANNOYING!**
- 7) **BE KIND**  
...to your travel guide, bus drivers, chaperones, condo staff, and everyone else. Exhibit fine manners and class at all times. Loud and rude behavior makes us all look bad.
- 8) **BE A GOOD PERSON**  
We are representing THE Permian High School. Conduct yourself with dignity, class, and humility. Immature and thoughtless acts will not be tolerated.
- 9) **BE ON TIME**  
Timeliness is an important characteristic of maturity. This includes respecting meeting times and lights-out schedules. Always remember:  

**If you're early, you're on time**  
**If you're on time, you're late**  
**If you're late, you're in trouble**
- 10) **"PLEASE" and "THANK YOU"**  
...are great words. Use them often.
- 11) **RELAX, BE PATIENT**  
Traffic delays and slow service are inevitable.
- 12) **DON'T BREAK THE ABOVE RULES**  
It will ruin the trip for your choir directors and place future trips in jeopardy. (Besides, it's a violation of Rule 6.)

## **Items To Bring / Luggage**

- You should bring one suitcase and one carry-on for the bus. You are permitted other small items, but you must be able to carry your own luggage without assistance. Remember, packing light is the way to go on a trip. A pillow and blanket for the bus is recommended!
- Packing List
  - Minimum of 3 face masks
  - Choir T-Shirt(s)
  - One nice dressy dinner outfit
  - Plenty of casual clothes
  - Bathing suit
  - Beach towel
  - Jacket / coat
  - Underclothes and pajamas
  - Toiletries
  - Medicines
  - Comfortable walking shoes (not sandals)
  - Sunglasses, hats, gloves, scarves, etc...
  - Pillow and something to do on the bus (book, iPod, etc.)
  - Spending money for souvenirs & some food

We recommend bringing \$100 for extraneous expenses. Less is okay, more is okay.

## **Medications**

- All medication (including non-prescription) must be properly labeled, and in the original container. Prescription medication must include on the label the name of the student, name of the medication, the dosage, and time the medication is to be administered.
- Every student must have a signed OVER THE COUNTER or PRESCRIBED Medication form on file. This form also counts as the "Medical Release" form.
- Please make your room chaperone aware of any medical condition that could need treatment – asthma, diabetes, etc.

## **Condo Rules**

- Nobody should enter rooms of the opposite gender. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Please respect the other guests of the condo by not making excessive noise in the hallways/public areas. Visit friends in the lobby or other meeting areas, not in the corridor.
- Each evening you will be given a time for Room Checks. After your room check you cannot leave your room for any reason. This includes going next door to your chaperones room to pickup something you forgot! This includes going back to the lobby to get water or a snack!
- Lights-out means that no lights are on, no phone calls, everyone in bed.
- Use your personal cell phones to communicate with your parents. Do not use room phones for any reason. Phones in the rooms will be blocked.
- You are not permitted to leave the condo property for any reason unless directed to do so by chaperones.
- Chaperones may not take students outside of condo property without the consent of Mr. Sieloff.
